Chartered Accountants, or CAs, are business professionals who generally work in four key areas. About 40% of CAs is in Public Practice, while the other 60% are employed in industry, government, or education.

### Public Practice

All CAs, at some time during their career, work as advisors in public practice, providing accounting and business advice to clients in areas such as small business tax, audit, information technology, personal financial planning, business valuation, receivership, insolvency and forensic investigation.

### Industry

CAs who works in industry develops financial and administrative policies, analyze information, and provide strategic leadership. CAs add value to organizations as CEO/President, Treasurer/V.P. Finance, Controller, or Systems Developer.

### Government

## CAP I/FOUNDATION LEVEL

The first stage is the passing of the CA Foundation level for which the eligibility is 10+2 or Intermediate pass or above. The papers, each of which is for 100 marks, of this level are grouped into two as per following details:

## CAP II/INTERMEDIATE LEVEL

The next stage in ICAN's program is the CA Intermediate Level. For this level the eligibility is given above. There are seven papers, each of which is for 100 marks, for this level into two groups as per details given here:

## CAPIII/FINAL LEVEL

After passing the Intermediate level papers, the final stage begins. The next/final stage consists of theoretical studies and practical (articles) training which begins immediately after passing Intermediate level. After completion of this stage, lasting three years at least, the final examination may be attempted for which two groups of papers, of 100 marks each, are as follows:

## COMMON PROFICIENCY TEST (CPT)

The test will be conducted in four subjects divided into two test sessions.

Session I -2hours- 100 marks		
Section A	Fundamentals of Accounting	60 marks
Section B	Mercantile Laws	40 marks
Session II-2hours- 100 marks		
Section C	General Economics	50 marks
Section D	Quantitative aptitude	50 marks

The entire test will be OBJECTIVE TYPE with negative markings for wrong answers given. The aggregate score must not be less than 50% to be eligible for further progress.

## WHAT IS ARTICLESHIP?

A student must undergo practical training for about 3 years which is termed as article-ship. The practical training is done after CA Intermediate under ICAN and after completion of CPT under ICAI. This is the period where students learn much more intensively about recording, processing, auditing and drafting of basic financial information to the preparation of Annual Financial Statements.

During articulated training, the ICAI/ICAN students are to be paid stipends as per respective regulations.

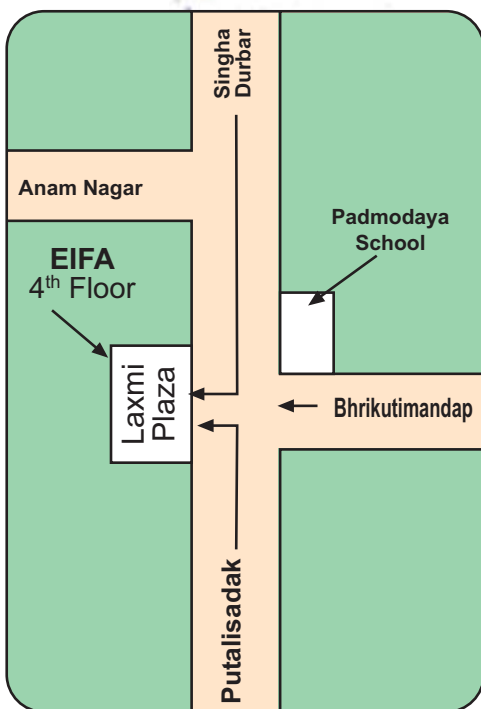
